Perimeter Wall:

Size: 498 linear meters

Characteristics: 340 m of prefabricated wall, 158 m of grid

Uses: The wall is important to protect the ground, especially when there is construction material. The grating area adjoins a public road.

Approximate Cost: US \$ 25,163

Status: 170 linear meters have already been built, 165 m of prefabricated wall and 158 m of grid are missing.

Construction Teams: Parkside Bible Church, Eastport Bible Church, EXITE Team. scheduled Texas team.

Missing Project Details: US \$16,163.04

Exterior:

Size: 22 linear meters

Characteristics: Entrance of vehicles of 5m long, access ramp for vehicles, 3m of wall of 2 m of high, 14m of mixed wall of block and grate. Facade systems.

Uses: Give a presentation to the church, which begins to be known by neighbors.

Approximate Cost: US\$2400

Status: 95% finished

Construction Teams: Contribution of Bible Community of Grace and of the Bible Church of Grace of Alajuela. Help from Seth Slippey and Aleman family.

Missing Project Details: Two light posts and sign with the name of the church - \$1500.

Playground:

Size: 490 m2

Characteristics: 3 sets of recycled tires, a slide, a handrail. Sowing in reforestation of 18 fruit trees and shade, sowing of lawn.

Uses: It is a tool to reach the community and the neighborhood. At this time the ministry of children is the strongest with 50 children approx.

Approximate Cost: US\$ 1200

Status: 98% finished

Construction Teams: Cabezas Guardia Family, CIMA Team, and Bethesda Church Contribution

Missing Project Details: One water sprinkler, 4 park benches and 1 mixed swing: \$850

Multifunctional Sports Court:

Size: 420 m2

Characteristics: Multifunctional court for volleyball, basketball, and soccer 5

Uses: It is a tool to reach the community and the neighborhood. At this time the youth ministry is 30 boys. No other churches in Nagarote are interested at this time in working with young people or are open to the community.

Approximate Cost: US\$9350

Status: Scheduled to start in June 2017

Construction Teams: Spokane Bible Church

Missing Project Details: A budget to start the gray area (\$5350), lacking soccer frames, basketball boards, and volleyball net calculated at a cost of \$4000.

Pavillion-Comedor:

Size: 154 m2

Characteristics: Two bathrooms with shower, a kitchen-cellar and a meeting area.

Uses: First, it will serve as a meeting place for all ministries (children, youth, adults), and when building the church, it will become a dining room for the use of the church and also serve children with limited resources their daily food.

Approximate Cost: US\$ 10000

Status: Under construction from February to May 2017

Construction Teams: Bible Community of Grace Contribution? and Eastport Bible Church contributions and offerings to the project through GMI.

Missing Project Details: Aesthetic details (mirrors, lamps, painting, fans). Approximate cost: \$ 600. Kitchen furniture, cost approx \$3000

Ministerial House:

Size: 176 m2

Characteristics: Two bedrooms, two bathrooms, an office, living room and dining room.

Uses: A home that can serve any missionary who is serving full time in Nagarote, which will be a pastoral house in the future.

Approximate Cost: US\$ 26 000

Status: Planned to be built in the early 2018

Entrance Esplanade:

Size: 140 m2

Characteristics: tough esplanade.

Uses: Vehicle parking, bicycles.

Septic Tank 1 and 2:

Size: 2 x 4 x 2 m

Characteristics: An underground septic tank, and a filtration drain.

Uses: Storage and treatment of black water from sanitary services of the dining room, central bathrooms and ministerial house.

Approximate Cost: US\$500 each

Status: Septic tank 1 planned to be built in February 2017.

Construction Teams: Nicaraguan labor

Missing Project Details: Septic tank 2 planned to be built in 2020

Size: 25 m2

Characteristics: Warehouse in gray work

Uses: Store building materials and tools.

Status: Scheduled for 2018

Bedrooms:

Size: 261 m2

Characteristics: A men's room for 10 people with bathrooms and showers, a women's room for 10 people with bathrooms and showers, a family room for 4 people, a laundry room and a small warehouse for supplies.

Uses: To receive foreign groups that support in ministry. Christian programs, retreats, and camps for church use and self-sustaining terrain.

Approximate Cost: US \$ 30,000

Status: Scheduled for the year 2020-2021

Characteristics: Street that communicates all the ground, in stone

Uses: Parking, communication, and dispatch of material and people.

Size: 15 m2 each

Status: Scheduled for 2019
